INVITATION TO BID

1. Notice is hereby given that the Owner:

Pajaro Sunny Mesa Community Services District 136 San Juan Road Royal Oaks, CA 95076

will receive sealed bids for performing the construction of:

SPRINGFIELD WELL NO. 2

according to the Drawings and Project Manual including Specifications prepared by Balance Hydrologics, Inc. accepted by the Owner and described in general as:

Location(s): The well will be installed in the northeast corner of the property of the Moss Landing Middle School, near Springfield Road, east of Highway 1.

Description of Work: Work includes the furnishing of all materials, labor, equipment, fuel, tools, transportation, and services for drilling, construction, development, testing, and completion of a water supply well as described in these specifications. The water well is generally described as consisting of a 16-inch diameter pilot bore to a depth of 600 feet, an 8-inch PVC slotted casing, with gravel pack and sanitary seal. Well development and baseline pumping at a rate of 300 gpm is required.

While the final drilling depths and design of the well may change based on the conditions encountered during the execution of the project, a detailed description of the well design is included in the contract documents.

- 3. A pre-bid conference will **NOT** be held for this project.
- 4. Sealed bids will be received at the District Office at the Address listed above until:

OCTOBER13th, 2016 at 10:00 AM local time.

Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened in public and read aloud shortly after the specified closing time. Interested parties are invited to attend.

5. Bid security made payable to the Owner is required to accompany each bid. Bid security shall be in the form of a cashier's or certified check or a Bid Bond as required by the Bid Security Document following the Bid Form.

6. Requirements for Public Works Contracts.

6.1 Wage Rates

Bidders are hereby notified that pursuant to provisions of Section 1770, et seq., of the Labor Code of the State of California, the Contractor shall pay its employees the general prevailing rate of wages as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations. In addition, the Contractor shall be responsible for compliance with the requirements of Section 1777.5 of the California Labor Code relating to apprentice public works contracts.

6.2 Registration Requirements

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

6.3 Reporting Requirements for Certified Payrolls

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable provisions of Section 16100 of Title 8 of the California Code of regulations, which require the Contractor to keep accurate records of work performed as provided in Labor Code Section 1812, to allow Owner to inspect contractor's payroll records pursuant to Labor Code Section 1776 and Section 16400(e) of Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations, and to comply with all requirements imposed by law. Access to the online certified payroll reporting system and information on current regulations regarding certified payroll reporting are available on the State of California Department of Industrial Relations website which can be accessed at the following link, http://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/Certified-Payroll-Reporting.html. All certified payroll shall be submitted monthly, along with the Progress Payment Request form. The Owner reserves the right to withhold progress payments until all proper certified payrolls have been received and verified.

6.4 License Requirements

The Contractor shall possess a valid State of California Class C-57 Specialty Contractor's License at the time of submitting a bid. The Contractor shall provide its license number classification and expiration date on the Bid Form.

6.5 Security in Lieu of Retainage

Provisions concerning the Contractors' rights to deposit security in lieu of retainage in accordance with California Public Contract Code Sections 10263 and 22300 are covered in the Agreement.

7. No bidder may withdraw its Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the time fixed for the opening of the bids, within which time an award will be made. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding.

9. Addenda

- a. Requests for information received less than 5 days prior to Bid opening may not be answered.
- b. Addenda will be issued no later than 3 days prior to Bid opening.
- c. Addenda will be posted on the District's website at the same location as the Contract Documents. It is the Contractor's responsibility to check for addenda prior to submission of the bid.

10. Time Constraints

- a. Bids shall remain in effect and subject to acceptance for 60 days after the date of Bid opening. If a contract is awarded, it will be awarded within the period that Bids are subject to acceptance.
- b. The Owner may issue the Notice to Proceed at any time between the time the Agreement is fully signed by all parties and 180 days thereafter.
- c. The Contract time shall begin to run on the date stated in the Notice to Proceed and the Contractor shall begin construction at the site within 10 days thereafter but not before submitting required insurance certificates.
- d. The Work shall be fully completed within the Contract Time which is sixty (60) days as stated in the Agreement.
